

See Amitabh Bachchan at Madame Tussauds Hong Kong

Visitors to Madame Tussauds in Hong Kong can now see one of India's most prominent film stars - Amitabh Bachchan.

On loan for the next four months from Madame Tussauds London, Amitabh Bachchan will take his place at the "World Famous Home of the Famous" at The Peak alongside other movie stars such as Jackie Chan, Johnny Depp, and Angelina Jolie.
